33. Give a compliment to a teammate.

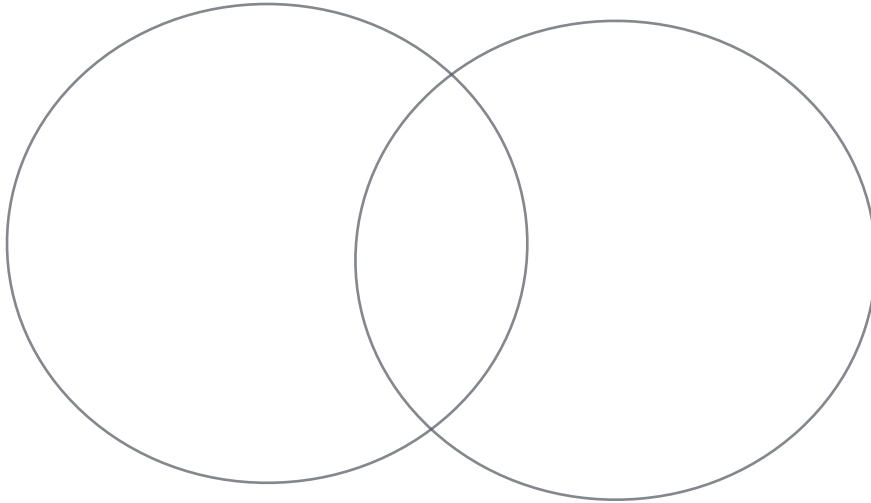
34. What countries would you like to travel to as a college student?
